Fact Car 9 crossed the white line at Pit Entry.

Offence Breach of Appendix L, Chapter IV, Article 4 d) and Article 12.1.1.i of the FIA

International Sporting Code

Decision Reprimand.

This is the drivers 1st reprimand of the current season.

Reason The driver of Car 9 (ERI) claimed that the proximity of Car 3 (RIC) caused a loss of

the Pit Lane. The probability of this being the case was confirmed by the Chief Engineer of Red Bull Racing. Notwithstanding this, the Stewards are of the view that

downforce, which in turn resulted in him oversteering over the white line at the entry to

the driver of Car 9, knowing that Car 3 was behind on a quick lap, should have reduced his speed earlier and allowed Car 3 to pass prior to the apex of the corner near the Pit

Entry.
