GENERAL INFORMATION

SOCHI AUTODROM SPECIFICS

UNIQUE FEATURES:

- Sochi Autodrom is the first circuit in Russia hosting the Formula 1 Grand Prix
- Sochi Autodrom is the only Russian circuit that operates all year-round.
- Sochi Autodrom is well integrated into the Olympic Park.
- The well-developed infrastructure - in close proximity to the Olympic Park and Sochi Autodrom - includes a wide range of modern hotels of different categories and a convenient transport network, with a nearby airport and a transport hub with train and bus connections.
- Sochi Autodrom is one of the few Formula 1 venues to have team buildings specially constructed near the pit boxes. These buildings allow teams to operate away from their motorhomes, thereby simplifying logistics considerably.
- Sochi Autodrom Race Control building is the first in the world to have a video control system with Real-Time Full HD technology - ensuring high quality images on 56 screens tracking the cars. The system is based on data collected from 48 Speed Dome cameras located on the perimeter of the racing track.
- On the eve of the 2017 FORMULA 1 VTB RUSSIAN GRAND PRIX, the TecPro safety barriers system in the second, fourth and thirteenth turns was strengthened according to the new requirements of the FIA, dictated by the increased speeds of the cars.

Race Control

The Race Control, the headquarters of the motorsport events management, a race director office, Formula One Management (FOM) and International Automobile Federation (FIA) offices (during the Formula 1 Russian Grand Prix), a timing room and engineering communications necessary for organising and controlling how the competition runs are located here.

Team Buildings

16 buildings for team members. On the ground floor, there are areas for catering and leisure, and a technical room. The first floor includes office rooms, drivers' leisure rooms and a terrace.

Pit Buildings

Pit buildings includes 33 team boxes (garages) (width of each – 6.80 m, length – 17.65 m), as well as FIA and FOM boxes and VIP suites with outside grandstands (F1 Paddock Club).

Media Centre

Used for accredited media representatives, includes a press workroom (336 seats), a photographers' area (104 seats), a press conference room (80 seats), a unilateral studio and a telecommunications centre.

Medical Centre

1 floor, 497 sq.m. located in the circuits perimeter, has a fully equipped reanimation room, two smaller surgery rooms, an X-ray room with digital X-ray, a burn treating shower and a treatment room.

Helipad

Area (30x30 m) intended for landing/take-off for air vehicles providing emergency resuscitation and transportation of victims.

Main Grandstand

A six-storey, 400 meters building; the slope of the Main Grandstand provides an unlimited view segment on the racing line.

Sports and Motorsports Competitions

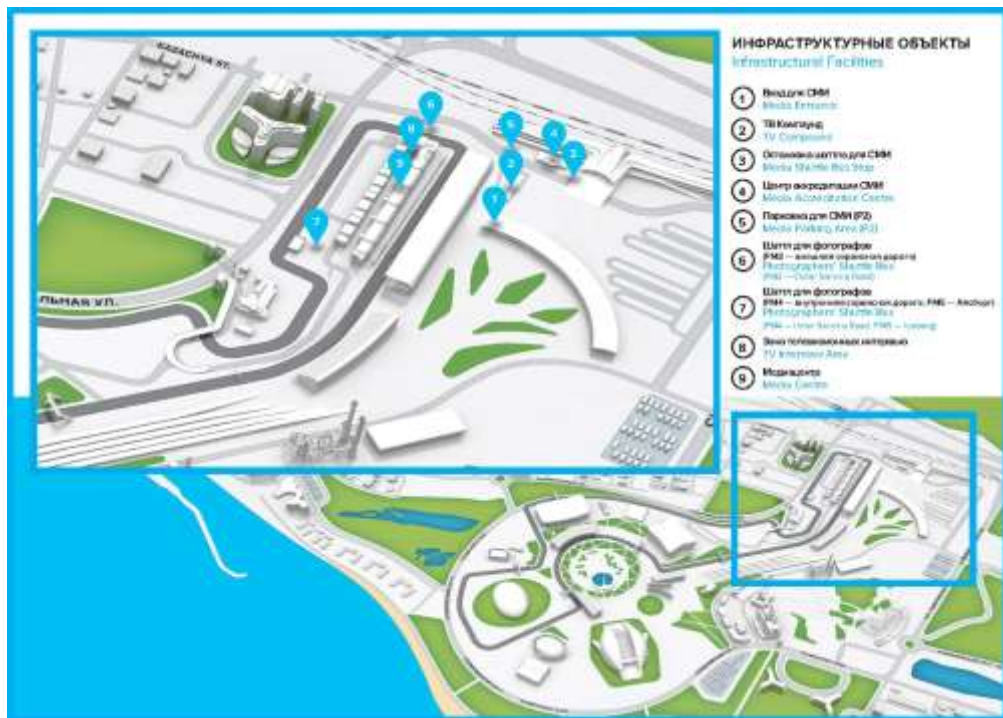
Since the opening of Sochi Autodrom in September 2014, the venue has hosted many sports events. Apart from the Formula 1 Grand Prix, a number of significant sporting events have been held here including the TCR International Series, the F4 NEZ Championship, the Russian Circuit Racing Series, the Max Power Cars and the Porsche Club Cup motorsport competitions, the Russian Triathlon Cup Final, the Mazda Sport Cup 2014 Final, the Sochi Half Marathon, the Russian Formula Masters (Formula 3 class) and the International race of the Mitjet 2L series

Commercial Services

The Autodrom's circuit allows it to host open track days, where motorsport fans get the opportunity to test the Formula 1 track for themselves. The Sochi Autodrom's team of professional drivers offers every visitor 'taxi rides' around the circuit. As part of regular venue tours, everyone also has a chance to visit the Race Control building; the team boxes and buildings, the Paddock Club and the VIP lounge.

Sochi Autodrom is also actively used as a site for corporate events. Companies are offered spacious rooms to hold press conferences, new product presentations and business meetings of all levels. Sochi Autodrom is ready to offer interesting sponsorship packages and an attractive advertising space to potential partners.

2017 FIA FORMULA ONE WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP

2017 REGULATION CHANGES

2017 features one of the biggest regulation shake-ups since the introduction of hybrid turbo power units in 2014. This time bodywork and tyres are the centre of attention, with both getting wider in order to boost downforce and grip, making the cars both faster and physically harder to drive.

Tyres. Tyres are around 25 percent wider than last season, with rear width up from 325mm to 405, and front width raised from 245 to 305.

Wings. The front wing span is increased from 1650mm to 1800mm. Note, that the overall width of the car is up from 1800mm to 2000mm. The height of the rear wing is reduced from 950mm to a maximum of 800mm.

Weight. Maximum weight is increased from 702kg to 728kg.

Power Units. A rule change has been made to prevent drivers stockpiling spare power unit elements. During any single event, if a driver introduces more than one of a power unit element that is subject to a grid penalty, only the last element fitted may be used at subsequent events without further penalty.

A number of changes have also been introduced aimed at reducing power unit costs, guaranteeing supply for customer teams, and closing the performance gap between engines.

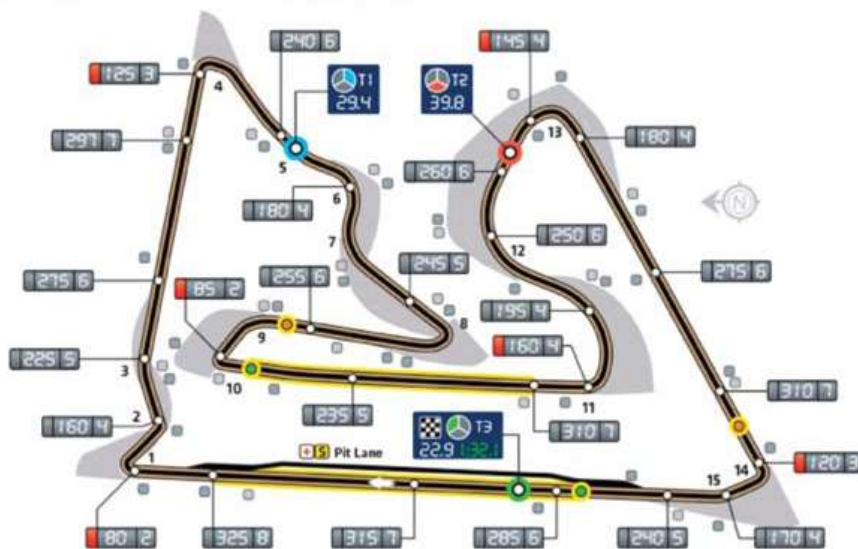

Mitjet 2L Arctic Cup

For the second time in history the Mitjet 2L Arctic Cup was authorised to become a support race to the FORMULA 1 RUSSIAN GRAND PRIX. The Mitjet 2L Arctic Cup weekend will consist of two 20 min races. 16 cars will be on the grid: 8 cars in PRO category and 8 cars – in Semi-PRO.

Mitjet 2L specs - tubular frame, plastic body, 2.0L 16V 230 HP engine, 6- gear sequential gearbox, rear wheel drive, 750 kg weight and 255/40 R18 semi slick tyres - is built safe and simple, to give all control into the drivers' hands - with no possible influence from the team or the budget. This makes for pure racing and a huge "spectacle" for the spectators on the race track.

Mitjet racing began in France - the French racer Jean-Philippe Dayraut was its founder in 2006. Slowly, this racing was held in other countries and in 2015, thanks to Arctic Energy Company and its owner Sergey Egorov's efforts, Mitjet 2L competitions were held in Russia for the first time. In the first season the Russian Championship for the RAF Cup was held, and in 2016 the series became the Russian Cup. The main event in the Mitjet 2L history was the inclusion of the series in the Formula 1 Russian Grand Prix programme at Sochi Autodrom.

The Mitjet Series Russia is based at Sochi Autodrom. In addition, they have the constantly operating professional Arctic Energy Racing School, headed by an acknowledged expert – Boris Shulmeyster.

During the 2017 FORMULA 1 VTB RUSSIAN GRAND PRIX on 27th to 30th April, the city public transport will be enhanced for the benefit of fans. The number of public buses will be increased and special bus routes in the Imeretinskaya Lowland will be introduced for the residents of the nearest hotels.

Railway transport

The fastest and the easiest way to get to Sochi Autodrom is by train. The suburban trains go to the Imeretinsky Kurort railway station (the Olympic Park station) located opposite the venue entrance.

During the 2017 FORMULA 1 VTB RUSSIAN GRAND PRIX, the Lastochka suburban train ticket barriers will be kept open on the following routes:

- Sochi – Imeretinsky Kurort – Sochi;
- Sochi – Airport – Sochi;
- Airport – Imeretinsky Kurort – Airport.

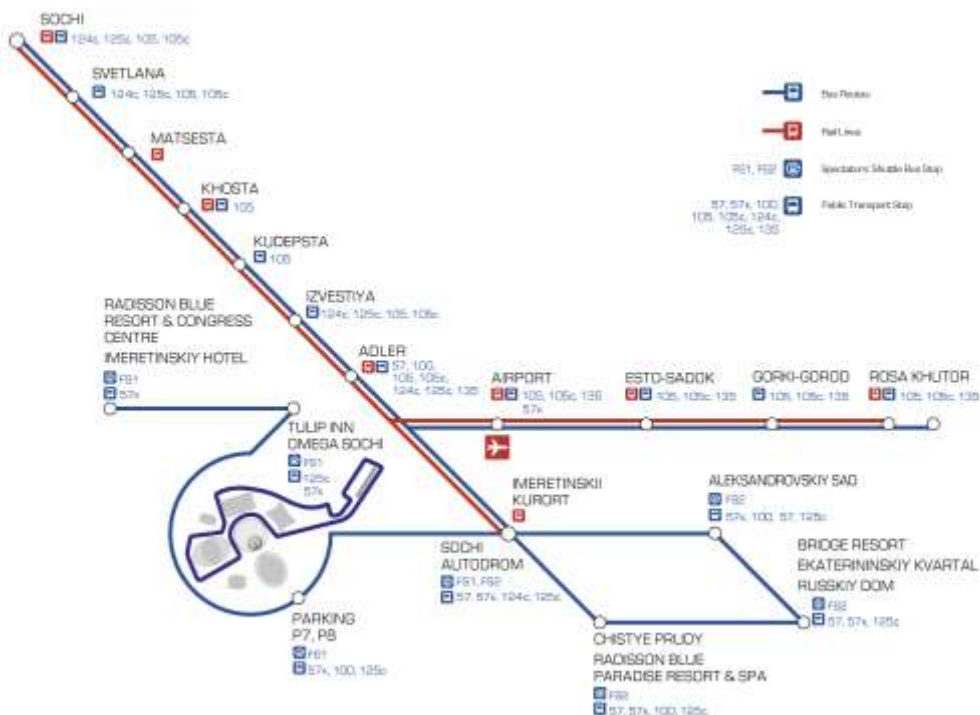
Regular buses

HOW TO GET TO SOCHI AUTODROM

Taxi

The taxi pick-up/drop-off area will be located at the square in front of the Imeretinsky Kurort railway station (parking area P18) and will be marked with the appropriate signs.

Personal car

There will be two paid parking areas available to 2017 FORMULA 1 VTB RUSSIAN GRAND PRIX guests arriving in personal vehicles, the access to those areas will be restricted to the holders of the special parking permits:

- Parking area P6 for buses located near the main entrance group;
- Parking area P8 for cars located opposite Sochi Park.

It is important to remember that for the period of the Formula 1 Russian Grand Prix restrictions on the access of personal vehicles to the area adjacent to Sochi Autodrom will be introduced, and it is better to order your parking permits in advance. The permits are available on www.sochiautodrom.ru and in the Sochi Autodrom box offices.

Road traffic restrictions near Sochi Autodrom

For vehicles without special access permits, except for public buses and taxis, the road traffic will be restricted over the period from 7:00 a.m. 27th April 2017 to 11:00 p.m. 30th April 2017 in the areas adjacent to the circuit in the following sections of the roads:

- In Triumfalnaya St. in front of the permanent VSA;
- Access to the Imeretinsky Kurort railway station from Chempionov St.;
- In Triumfalnaya St. in front of the Tulip Inn hotel;
- Access to the Imeretinsky Kurort railway station from Kazachya St. and Triumfalniy Proezd.

The traffic will be stopped from 7:00 a.m. 27 April 2017 to 11:00 p.m. 30 April 2017 in the following sections:

- Exit from Zhurnalistov St. to Triumfalnaya St.;
- Exit from Starookhotnichya St. to Triumfalnaya St.;
- Exit from Pereletnaya St. to Triumfalnaya St.

SOCHI AT A GLANCE

Sochi is one of the southernmost regions in Russia and the second-largest city in the Krasnodar region. Located along the Black Sea coast, it is approximately 1,600km (995 mi) south of Moscow. The city has a permanent population of 401,291 (2016) and Greater Sochi (includes four administrative districts: Central Sochi District, Lazarevskoye District, Khosta District, and Adler District) has 480,215 residents, making it Russia's largest resort city.

Sochi is often unofficially called the 'Summer Capital' of Russia, or the Black Sea Pearl. Sochi is the biggest and busiest summer sea resort in Russia, attracting more than four million visitors annually with its amazing mountainous coastline, endless shingle beaches, warm sunny days, and bustling nightlife. From May to September Sochi's population at least doubles with tourists, including celebrities, and the political elite of the country visiting the region

Sochi belongs to a tiny part of Russia, which is located in the subtropical climatic zone. This makes Sochi an ideal place to visit all year-round.

Greater Sochi occupies 145km along the Black Sea coastline. Its total area is 3,500km² (2,175 sq. mi) - three times larger than Moscow. However, most of the population is spread along the narrow coastline stripe, while the mountain area (1,900km²/1,180mi²) mostly belongs to Sochi National Park and partly to the Caucasian Biosphere Reserve.
