Fact Unsafe release from a pit stop

Offence Breach of Article 28.13 (a) of the FIA Formula One Sporting Regulations.

Decision 5 Second Time Penalty.

Reason The stewards reviewed the video, including the in car video, of the incident between WEH and BUT in the pit lane and determined that the team of car 94 released the car too late, and well after the guide board, requiring BUT to take actions to avoid a collision at the narrow exit of the pits. As the two cars were competing for position, and WEH therefore exited the pits in front, the stewards determined that releasing the car in this manner gained a sporting advantage for WEH.
