The above drivers did not finish the last race in Silverstone and are in conformity with Article 23.5a of the 2017 Formula One Sporting Regulations.

The above driver did finish the last race in Silverstone and this gearbox change was before the six consecutive Events expired. As this is not in compliance with Article 23.5a of the 2017 Formula One Sporting Regulations, I am referring this matter to the stewards for their consideration.
