The Stewards, having received a report from the Technical Delegate (Document 27), heard from a team representative, and examined video/telemetry evidence, have considered the following matter and determine the following.

**No / Driver** 26 - Daniil Kvyat

**Competitor** Scuderia Toro Rosso

**Time** 17:49

**Session** Qualifying

**Fact** Car 26 did not comply with Article 3.17.5 (front floor deflection test).

**Offence** Alleged Breach of Article 2.4 of the FIA Formula One Technical Regulations

**Decision** No further action.

**Reason** The team produced evidence that the car suffered an impact which reduced the downforce and resulted with a slower lap time than in Q2.  
Therefore whilst technically the car failed to pass the deflection test, the stewards have decided not to impose any penalty. However the team is reminded that further tests will be conducted and that future failure of the test may not result in the same decision.  
The FIA technical team is requested to further study the telemetry produced by the team and provide a report to the Stewards if appropriate.
