The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

<b>No / Driver</b>	23 - Alexander Albon
<b>Competitor</b>	Aston Martin Red Bull Racing
<b>Time</b>	15:15
<b>Session</b>	Race
<b>Fact</b>	T1 incident with car.
<b>Offence</b>	Breach of Article 2 b) Chapter IV Appendix L of the FIA International Sporting Code.
<b>Decision</b>	5 second time penalty (2 penalty points imposed, total of 5 points in the 12-month period).
<b>Reason</b>	The Stewards viewed video evidence. It was obvious that although not intentional, car 23 did not leave the required one car width when moving back to the racing line which resulted in contact between the two cars.  Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 10.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
