The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

Competitor Hitech Grand Prix

Time 11:49

Session Race 2

Fact Car 7 and Car 8 made contact at Turn 1 after the second safety car restart.

Offence Alleged breach of Appendix L, Chapter IV, Article 2 (d) of the FIA International

Sporting Code.

Decision No further action.

Reason The Stewards examined video evidence. Having considered the matter extensively,

the Stewards determined that on the restart Cars 8 and 7 were following each other closely. The leading car, Car 21, locked the brakes into Turn 1 and Car 8 reacted. Car 7 did the same but made minimal contact with Car 8. The Stewards determined that neither driver was wholly or predominantly at fault and hence a racing incident,

with no further action taken.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
