The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No / Driver 7 - Marcus Armstrong

Competitor Hitech Grand Prix

Time 09:51

Session Race 2

Fact There was alleged to be contact between Car 7 (Marcus Armstrong), Car 1 (Dennis Hauger) and Car 24 (David Beckmann) at Turn 13 at 09:51 in the Feature Race.

Offence Alleged breach of Appendix L, Chapter IV, Article 2 (d) of the FIA International Sporting Code.

Decision No further action.

Reason The Stewards examined video & data evidence. They summoned and heard the drivers and team representatives (documents 56, 57 & 58).

Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determined that Car 7 had a mechanical failure on the car at the exit of Turn 12 causing it to slow. It was hit unavoidably by first Car 24 and then Car 1. The Stewards, therefore, take no further action.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
