The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

Fact Car 4 was released from his pit stop location for the reconnaissance lap in front of

Car 20 (Richard Verschoor) who was already in the fast lane.

Offence Breach of Article 28.11 (a) of the FIA Formula 2 Sporting Regulations.

Decision A fine of 500 Euros to be paid by the Team. In accordance with Article 12.8.1 of the

ISC, fines shall be paid within forty-eight hours of their notification by means of bank

transfer to the FIA.

Reason The Stewards examined video evidence. They summoned and heard the drivers and

team representatives (documents 54 & 55).

Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determined that when the lollipop went up, Car 4's pull away was slower than normal which made him reach the fast lane almost side by side with Car 20 who braked to avoid potential contact.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
