The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No / Driver 3 - Jack Doohan

Competitor Virtuosi Racing

**Time** 11:56

Session Qualifying

Fact Car 3 was alleged to have set his fastest lap (1.21.432) under single yellow flag

conditions at 11:56 in Qualifying Group A.

Offence Alleged breach of Appendix H, Article 2.5.5 (b) of the FIA International Sporting Code.

**Decision** No further action.

**Reason** The Stewards examined video and timing evidence. They summoned and heard the

driver and team representative (document 17).

Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determined that the Driver did noticeably reduce his speed in the 2 mini sectors where the single yellow flags were displayed for the stranded Car 11. His time in the last two mini sectors was almost 0.700s slower than his best time in those mini sectors. During the hearing, it was furthermore established that the Driver did not use his DRS from the exit of Turn 19 until he had just arrived at the stationary Car 11, and that he did not go on the exit kerbs at Turn 19 as he would have done during previous fast laps. As all these elements made it evident that the driver had noticeably reduced his speed, the Stewards decide to take no further action.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
