The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

Competitor Trident Motorsport

Time 11:46

Session Qualifying

Fact Team personnel from Trident failed to wear helmets during the pit stop (change of tyres) that took place in Qualifying Group A.

Offence Breach of Article 28.10 of the FIA Formula 2 Sporting Regulations.

Decision A fine of 1000 Euros to be paid by the Competitor. In accordance with Article 12.8.1 of the ISC, fines shall be paid within forty-eight hours of their notification by means of bank transfer to the FIA.

In addition, a fine of 2000 Euros is suspended until the end of this season, which will be implemented for any similar violation of pit stop procedure (team personnel not wearing appropriate helmets during a pit stop).

Reason The Stewards examined video evidence. They summoned and heard the team representative (document 23).

The video footage clearly shows that the team personnel did carry out work on the car during a pit stop without wearing helmets.

The Team Representative did acknowledge the infringement and apologised for this. Not wearing compulsory safety equipment might result in a very critical situation and therefore the Stewards imposed the penalty above to make sure the Team pay attention to this situation in future.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
