The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**No / Driver** 24 - David Beckmann

**Competitor** Van Amersfoort Racing

**Time** 18:33

**Session** Race 1

**Fact** Incidents at Turn 1 & Turn 2 involving Car 24 (Beckmann) and Car 17 (Iwasa) in the Sprint Race.

**Offence** Breach of Article 27.3 of the FIA Formula 2 Sporting Regulations.

**Decision** No further action.

**Reason** The Stewards examined video evidence. They summoned and heard the drivers and team representatives (documents 48 & 49).

Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determined that Car 24 was attempting a pass on Car 17 on the inside of T1. At the turn in point Car 17 turned earlier than normal and squeezed Car 24 on to the curb at the apex. As a result Car 24 ran wider than normal and Car 17, to avoid a collision cut through the inside of T2 and came out ahead of Car 24. Car 17 having gained an advantage gave it back before T4. Both drivers contributed to the incident in both corners and neither is deemed wholly or predominately at fault.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
