The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No / Driver 31 - Joseph Loake

Competitor Rodin Motorsport

Time 09:53

Session Race 1

Fact Car 31 (Loake) failed to start the Race from the Pit Lane after causing an extra formation lap.

Infringement Breach of Article 37.11 b) of the 2024 FIA Formula 3 Sporting Regulations.

Decision Ten second Stop & Go Penalty in accordance with Article 39.3 (d) of the FIA F3 Sporting Regulations. There are no penalty points associated with this decision.

Reason The Stewards examined video evidence. Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determined that the Driver of Car 31 (Loake) caused the start of the F3 Sprint Race to be aborted.

Article 37.11 (b) of the 2024 FIA F3 Sporting Regulations mandates that any driver causing the start to be aborted, and who is then able to start the extra formation lap, must subsequently enter the pit lane at the end of the lap and start the race from pitlane. Car 31 did not comply with this regulation and failed to enter pitlane and start the race from there.

As per the aforementioned article, a mandatory penalty of a “10 second stop-and-go” is imposed on any driver who fails to start the race from the pit lane.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
