The Stewards, having received a request from the Team, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No / Driver 7 - Jak Crawford

Competitor DAMS Lucas Oil

Time 11:16

Session Race 2

Fact Car 7 (Crawford) does not have the correct number of tyres to comply with the Sporting Regulations in relation to the Feature Race (Race 2).

Infringement Breach of Article 24.15 of the FIA Formula 2 Sporting Regulations.

Decision A drop of 5 grid places for the Feature Race (Race 2). No driver penalty points are associated with this infringement.

Reason The Stewards summoned and heard the team representative (document 30). Having considered the matter extensively and discussed the situation with the Technical Delegate, the Stewards determined that during the Qualifying session, Car 7 rendered the left rear tyres of both "option" compound sets of tyres unusable for safety reasons, as certified by the tyre supplier. This was deemed by the Stewards to be not for reasons of force majeure. Car 7, is therefore, not able to comply with SR 24.15 for the Feature Race (Race 2). The grid drop of 5 places applies to the Feature Race as this is when the tyre is required to be used.

The Stewards direct the tyre supplier to provide a new "option" left rear tyre to Car 7 for use only in the Feature Race (Race 2). The tyre supplier is requested to mount and issue this tyre to the Team after the conclusion of the Sprint Race (Race 1).

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
