The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

Fact A team member moved onto the fast lane to stop cars being released from the inner

lane.

Infringement Breach of Article 12.2.1.h of the FIA International Sporting Code

Decision A fine of 1,000 Euros to be paid by the Team. In accordance with Article 12.8.1 of the

ISC, fines shall be paid within forty-eight hours of their notification by means of bank

transfer to the FIA.

Reason The Stewards examined video evidence. They summoned and heard the Team

Representative (document 52).

During the release of cars procedure from pitlane to the grid, a team member of PREMA Racing moved (jumped) into the fast lane to stop and/or slow down the already released cars.

Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determined the team member had placed himself and potentially others in an unsafe situation as a result of the action. Fortunately, no person(s) was injured.

As per Article 9.15.1 of the 2024 FIA International Sporting Code, the Competitor is responsible for all acts or omissions on the part of any person taking part in a Competition. This includes Drivers, mechanics, consultants, service providers, or passengers, as well as any person to whom the Competitor has allowed access to the Reserved Areas. As such the Stewards determined that the Competitor is in breach of the regulations, and this penalty is applied.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
