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## **BULLETIN 2 – Amendment to FIA F3 Sporting Regulation Articles 33.3, 35.2 and 36.2**

The following changes have been made to the F3 Sporting Regulations with immediate effect in accordance to Article 1.3 of the FIA F3 Sporting Regulations.

### **33.3**

In Monaco, two groups will be created (group A and group B); these groups will consist of those cars with even numbers and those with odd numbers. A ballot to establish the order in which the two groups will run in the qualifying session will take place on the day of scrutineering. Group (A) will take part in the first 16 minutes of the qualifying session; Group (B) will take part in the last 16 minutes of the qualifying session.

In Monza, two groups will be created (group A and group B); these groups will consist of those cars with even numbers and those with odd numbers. A ballot to establish the order in which the two groups will run in the qualifying session will take place on the day of scrutineering. Group (A) will take part in the first 13 minutes of the qualifying session; Group (B) will take part in the last 13 minutes of the qualifying session.

### **35.2**

An alternative Sprint race grid may be arranged in Monaco and in Monza. The overall fastest driver from both groups will start the race from 12<sup>th</sup> position. The 11<sup>th</sup> place on the grid will be awarded to the driver who has achieved the fastest time in the other group and 10<sup>th</sup> place will be awarded to the driver who has achieved the second fastest time in the group of the overall fastest driver, and so on.

By way of illustration:

The Qualifying Group that contains the fastest qualifying car overall shall be the “Pole Group”. The other group shall be the “Second Group”.

## 36.2

The grid will be drawn up in the order of the fastest time achieved by each driver during the qualifying practice session. Should two or more drivers have set identical times, priority will be given to the one who set it first.

An alternative Feature race grid may be arranged in Monaco **and in Monza**. The overall fastest driver from both groups will start the race from pole position. The second place on the grid will be awarded to the driver who has achieved the fastest time in the other group and third place will be awarded to the driver who has achieved the second fastest time in the group of the overall fastest driver, and so on.
