The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**No / Driver** 21 - Josep Maria Marti

**Competitor** Campos Racing

**Time** 13:48

**Session** Race 1

**Fact** Car 21 (Marti) made contact with the rear of Car 17 (Aron) at Turn 5.

**Infringement** Alleged breach of Appendix L, Chapter IV, Article 2 (d) of the FIA International Sporting Code.

**Decision** No further action.

**Reason** The Stewards examined video evidence. They summoned and heard the drivers and team representatives (documents 29 & 30).

The Driver of Car 17 explained that he had a mechanical problem from the exit of Turn 3 to Turn 5. His engine cut power, which caused a big difference of speed with Car 21. The Driver of Car 17 explained that he tried to move out of the way to avoid a collision, but Car 21 made contact with the back of Car 17 at the exit of Turn 5.

The Driver of Car 21 explained that he saw Car 2 overtaking Car 17 at Turn 4, and that the visibility was very poor approaching Turn 5. He admitted seeing Car 17 driving slow at Turn 5. Despite lifting to try to avoid a collision, he couldn't stop the car in time and made contact with the back of Car 17. Video evidence is consistent with the drivers' explanations.

The Stewards concluded that Car 21 was not responsible for the collision. Therefore, the Stewards decided that no further action was needed.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
