The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No / Driver 17 - Charlie Wurz

Competitor Jenzer Motorsport

Time 18:37

Session Race 1

Fact Car 17 (Wurz) caused a collision with Car 9 (Dunne).

Infringement Breach of Appendix L, Chapter IV, Article 2 d) of the FIA International Sporting Code.

Decision Ten seconds (10) time penalty in accordance with Article 39.3 (d) of the F3 Sporting Regulations, converted to a drop of five (5) places on the grid for the next race in which the driver participates. In addition, 2 penalty points are to be added to the Driver's record. Total for the 2024 season = 4 points

Reason The Stewards examined video evidence. They summoned and heard the Drivers and Team Representatives (Documents 41 & 42).

Car 9 (Dunne) attempted to pass Car 17 (Wurz) on the left on the straight between Turns 5 and 6. Car 17 initially left a car width to the left, as he believed he was required to do. Car 9 continued the passing attempt and achieved sufficient overlap to be entitled to racing room to the left of Car 17. As the cars proceeded towards Turn 6 and passed under the bridge crossing the circuit, Car 17 continued drifting to the left which ultimately forced Car 9's left side tires fully onto the grass, which remained wet from earlier rains. Car 9 lost control of his car at that point, returned to the track and collided with Car 17, who subsequently retired from the race.

Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards find Car 17 wholly responsible for the collision and assess the standard penalty of 10 seconds, converted to a 5 grid place drop for the next race in which the driver participates and also assess two penalty points.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
