The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No / Driver 17 - Charlie Wurz

Competitor Jenzer Motorsport

Time 15:34

Session Qualifying

Fact Car 17 (Wurz) left the track at Turn 18 deliberately without a justifiable reason and

gained an advantage.

Infringement Breach of Appendix L, Chapter IV, Article 2 c) of the FIA International Sporting Code.

Decision A drop of 3 places on the grid for the next race in which the Driver participates. There

are no penalty points associated with this decision.

Reason The Stewards examined video evidence. They summoned and heard the Driver and

Team Representative (Document 23).

The driver of Car 17 (Wurz) stated that he was setting up for a fast lap. There was less than a minute remaining until the end of the qualifying session and the driver needed to secure a better qualifying lap time. Video footage showed that the driver went off track and while doing so overtook several cars to gain a better position to start his fast lap.

Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards find that the driver is in breach of the regulations by deliberately leaving the track without a justifiable reason. The Stewards asses a penalty of 3-place grid drop and no penalty points.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
