The Stewards, having received a report from the Technical Delegate, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**Team Manager** MP Motorsport

**Competitor** MP Motorsport

**Time** 09:39

**Session** Race 1

**Fact** Alleged staff on the Pit Wall stand who did not appear to be Team Operational Personnel.

**Infringement** Alleged breach of Article 21.5 of the 2024 FIA Formula 3 Sporting Regulations.

**Decision** No further action.

**Reason** The Stewards examined photo evidence. They summoned and heard the Team Representative (Documents 46).

The Stewards received photos from the Technical Delegate which showed people that did not appear to be Team Operational Personnel on the Pit Wall Timing stand during the race. In the subsequent hearing the Team explained that the personnel in question were declared non-Operational Personnel for the series, which the Stewards verified, and that they were under strict orders to not engage with Operational Personnel in any way while they were there, in particular but not limited to, by the use of any radio. The Stewards, having received no evidence to the contrary, take the Team's word at face value and, therefore, take no further action.

However, all Teams are cautioned that the strict regulations regarding Operational Personnel exist for their own benefit and any breaches of those regulations in the future will be dealt with harshly, as has happened in the past, with penalties possibly including disqualifications.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
