The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No / Driver 18 - Maxwell Esterson

Competitor Jenzer Motorsport

Time 14:34

Session Qualifying

Fact Car 18 (Esterson) impeded Car 1 (Beganovic) at Turn 16.

Infringement Appendix L, Chapter IV, Article 2 b) of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article

31.6 of the 2024 FIA Formula 3 Sporting Regulations.

Decision A drop of 3 places on the grid for the next race in which the Driver participates. There

are no penalty points associated with this decision.

Reason The Stewards examined video evidence. They summoned and heard the Drivers and

Team Representatives (Documents 17, 18 & 19).

Car 1 (Beganovic) was on a fast lap on the approach to Turn 15. Car 5 (Mequetounif) was ahead on the racing line and on the exit immediately reacted by turning to the right hand side off the racing line to allow Car 1 to continue unimpeded, however on the approach to Turn 16, several cars were preparing for fast laps.

On entry to Turn 16 Car 24 (Van Hoepen) passed Car 18 (Esterson) who then moved to the right hand side of the track unaware that Car 1 was approaching at speed as his vision had been impaired.

Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determine Car 18 clearly impeded Car 1 on the approach to Turn 16, for which the driver of Car 18 is judged wholly responsible. The Stewards assess the standard 3 grid place penalty for this infringement in the Driver's next race.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
